The Zircons continued to learn about our planets with a visit from one of our parents.

Mr Mackintosh generously gave up his time to talk to the class about his orrery, a mechanical model of the solar

system. Using the model, Mr Mackintosh expertly demonstrated the movement of Earth and the other planets in relation to the Sun. He also explained day and night, caused by the Earth's rotation, and showed us how the moon moves in relation to the Earth.

The class found the demonstration incredibly valuable, especially as it linked in with our science work on 'Earth & Space'.
