An enormous well done to the 18 KS2 and 7 KS1 Godolphin runners who competed in the 5th XC League match of the season at Mullion on Monday.

The children all ran incredibly well and achieved some excellent positions.

A special mention to Aaron in Year 6 who has finished 1st place in all five league matches this season.

As a result of completing five races this season, Godolphin already have 14 children who have earned themselves an 'Endurance' medal, with a further 9 children in contention for a medal if they compete in the **sixth and final race**, scheduled for **next Tuesday 23rd May at Helston Community College**.

Joining the KS2 runners this week were seven of our up-and-coming children from Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. The budding athletes pushed themselves all the way and finished in some fantastic positions. Well done to all of our young superstars of the future!

Thank you to Miss Bradbury for taking charge of the team and scoring at this match, and thanks also to the parents, family and friends who made the journey down to Mullion and supported the team! We couldn't do it without you!

Don't forget, the sixth and final league race is next Tuesday 23rd May! If we have any chance of winning the league overall this year (second at the moment and closing in on Parc Eglos!) we'll need as many KS2 runners as possible as everyone earns points for the school regardless of positions.



Community Event: CPR Training:

Role 1 Medical have been working closely with Helston Community College over the past 12 months to deliver basic CPR training to all students at HCC.

There are around 60,000 cases of suspected cardiac arrest every year, but fewer than 1 in 10 people survive an out of hospital cardiac arrest.

With adequate training, immediate initiation of CPR can double or quadruple survival from out of hospital cardiac arrest. And defibrillation within 3-5 minutes of collapse can produce survival rates up to 50 – 70%.

Role 1 Medical would now like to offer CPR training to all parents/carers and the wider Helston community. As such, HCC are hosting a training event on **Wednesday 14 June 2023 between 6.00pm and 7.00pm** in the North Site Main Hall of Helston Community College.

The training costs as little as £8.00 per person to be trained by Paramedics that operate on the frontline daily.
