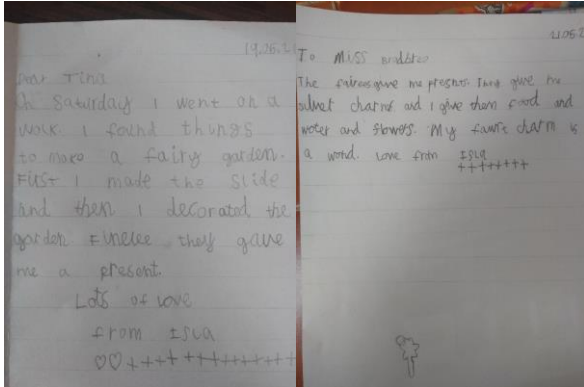

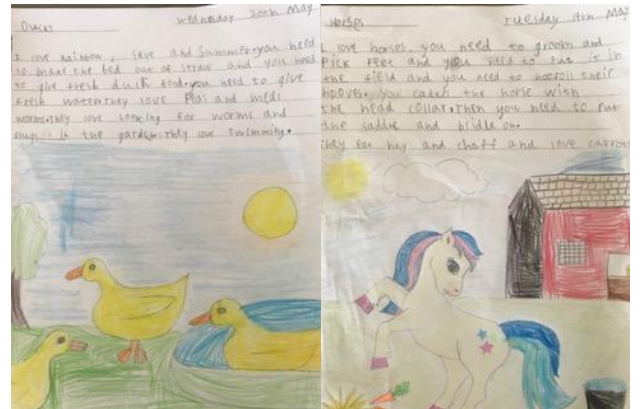
Rollo experimented in his garden to see which objects floated and which sank.

Jack has been working in the sunshine to create his Solar System.



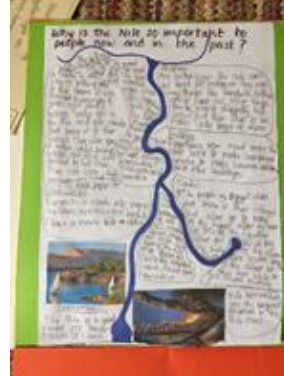
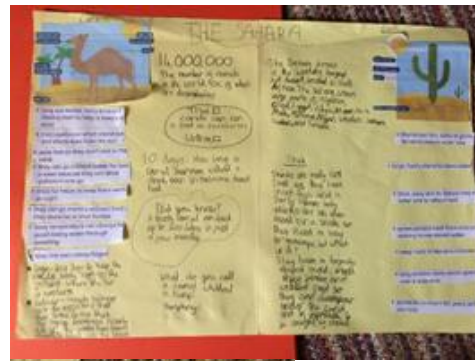
