Attendance:

We appreciate that at this time of year that children become unwell with colds, coughs etc. We also understand that parents are apprehensive about the similarities with Covid19 symptoms.

Could we ask parents to follow the normal school protocols for reporting illness (and contact the school each day your child is off school)? However due to Covid19, we do have to report suspected cases. To assist us in this, we ask that when parents use the answer phone or call to report a child's absence, they provide us with the following information;

- does your child have any new high temperature where they feel hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure the temperature)?
- does your child have a new continuous cough: coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours?
- does your child have a loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste: a noticeable loss of smell or taste or things smell and taste different to normal?
- have you followed the advice from 111 website? They have a helpful questionnaire for parents.
- are you planning to seek a test or are you waiting for results?
